

EARLY LITERACY PROGRAMS

Cochrane Public Library is committed to developing Early Literacy skills for caregivers of children from birth to age 5. Supporting Early Literacy Development introduces the caregiver to songs, rhymes, movement, and stories that share how to teach children important aspects of brain development and life skills. This includes aspects of: building language and literacy skills, social and emotional skills, and basic math concepts.



Program facilitators introduce early learning strategies in a fun and developmentally appropriate manner which is most effective with an attentive and participatory caregiver. These skills directly correlate to being ready for and succeeding in formal schooling. You are your child's first teacher and your participation is critical to your child's success. When you participate you are creating a sense of security and love by interacting with your child in fun and loving ways. Children who feel safe and secure are better able to learn. We look forward to helping you grow a reader!

NEW FOR SPRING

All Early Literacy sessions are drop in to a maximum of 20 people. Program passes will be available on a first come, first served basis.

Due to the popularity of Movers and Shakers and Storytime, these sessions will run twice in the same morning back to back. If passes are not available, caregivers are welcome to enjoy the children's area until passes are available for the second session. All Early Literacy sessions will be held in the Library Activity Room.

ROOM RENTALS

The Library's Spray Lake Board Room is available for rent. Free for not-for-profits, this room can seat 12-15, is wheelchair accessible, and has Wi-Fi.

• 3D PRINTING

The Library has an Ultimaker 3 printer that allows us to create custom 3D models. Prints are charged by weight, \$0.20 per gram.

The Library offers proctoring services subject to the requirements of the issuing educational institutions and the availability of the Library staff and resources. \$20.00 per exam.


