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Overview of the Event


52 individuals participated in the Community Input and Ideas Conversation on March 18, 2023 to talk about their ideas for the Cochrane community and the public library. These individuals represented a wide diversity of community organizations, demographics, and interests. They discussed three questions through interactive small and large group work.

- 1. What do you want in your community?
- 2. What are the main challenges that Cochrane faces?
- 3. How could the public library address the challenges and achieve your vision for Cochrane?

Library Chair, Cyndie Baum, welcomed the participants and thanked them for their willingness to give ideas for the library's Plan of Service. Barb Pedersen of Barbara Pedersen Facilitation Services Inc. facilitated the session and produced this report.

Activity: Each table group prepared a response on a flipchart page; then presented it to another table group to receive feedback about what they liked and what could be improved. The group then revised their response.


